SY26	Goal: Increase the percentage of students in Grades 5 and 8 achieving proficiency (Level 3 or above) on the Florida Statewide Science Assessment by at least 5 percentage points from the previous school year. Method for evaluating success/progress: *Comparison of 2024–2025 and 2025–2026 Science Assessment results. *Ongoing progress monitoring through quarterly benchmark assessments using Progress Learning. Goal: Increase overall proficiency (Level 3 or above) on the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) ELA by at least 5 percentage points across Grades 3–8. Method for evaluating success/progress: *Analysis of FAST progress monitoring data (PM1–PM3). *Review of i-Ready Reading diagnostic and growth data. *Data chats held after each assessment window to guide instruction and intervention. Goal: Increase parent involvement by providing more opportunities for families to engage in their child's learning and school community. Method for evaluating success/progress: *Track attendance and participation at family engagement events, workshops, and conferences. *Compare parent survey results related to communication and school involvement from fall to spring.
